This exciting programme aims to combat the root causes of poverty, promote social inclusion, challenge long-term unemployment and empower socially excluded people. 22.5 hours per week, Salary £23,000 pro rata (£13,986 per 22.5hr). The successful candidate will have to complete 6 months probationary period. This post is until the end of October 2019

You will work directly with unemployed and economically inactive participants by effectively delivering a holistic, personalised support service, which empowers participants with the self-belief, skills, motivation and confidence to enable them to progress into employment, self-employment or further training/education. The successful candidate will facilitate a range of Employability and Personal Development 1:1 or group sessions. You will provide participants with comprehensive Initial Assessments, plan and deliver their learning & development, evaluate and measure their progress and engagement. You will play an important role in helping individuals to overcome their fears and barriers and to develop their employability skills.

The successful person will have:

Ideally you will hold or be working towards a recognised Information, Advice & Guidance (IAG) qualification (minimum of Level 3 or above)

- Ideally previous experience of supporting and placing unemployed/ economically inactive people with multiple & complex needs into employment, self-employment or Further Education/Training.
- Previous paid or unpaid experience or skills of getting people into work and helping them to develop. Ability to use relevant transferable skills and to follow the process of step by step support involving action planning, reviewing progress and implementing appropriate Employability & Jobsearch techniques.
- Ability to negotiate and agree 'SMART' objectives with participants, experienced in giving constructive feedback and able to positively transform negative behaviours
- Knowledge and understanding of the Local Labour Market, Sector Skills Gaps, local Employment & Skills provision, Specialist Support Networks, and Education & Training providers
- Previous experience of working with Eastern European migrants & an understanding of the issues affecting Eastern European migrants to the UK, commitment to easing the process of their integration and promoting community cohesion
- > Fluency in both written and spoken English and Polish
- > Ability to contribute to SPS and the services it provides
